PURPOSE: The purpose of this Reference Guide is to update the high school elective course codes and course descriptions for students with disabilities on the alternate curriculum. Course codes should be used beginning 2009/2010 school year.

MAJOR CHANGES: Course codes in special education have been assigned and the course descriptions have been updated and aligned to the California academic standards and the Career and Technology standards. Elective strands aligned to career pathways are identified. Some courses have been deleted.

BACKGROUND: The intended curriculum for students with disabilities instructed in alternate standards parallels the standards-based curriculum used in general education and in Career and Technical education. Embedded within the elective course descriptions are activities that align with the Individuals With Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requirements for transition services and activities. The services and activities focus on preparing students for employment, further education or training, and independent living. Special education teachers should adhere to the instructional objectives identified in the course description to ensure that students are receiving required transition services.

PROCEDURES: The scope and sequence is designed to outline the high school instructional program for students with disabilities on the alternate curriculum. Schools should use the course codes identified to provide specialized electives for students with disabilities. The electives are aligned with career pathways and are designed to support the development of a School-Based Enterprise in the 11th grade and beyond.
